

Chair Descriptions Conservation Chair

The Conservation Chair is to promote general education, awareness and practice of conservation. They can be things such as:

- Education programs concerning conservation such as with water, soil, energy
- Establish recycling projects to help out with established programs
- Find out what conservation programs are in place in our community and solicit volunteers to help out
- Start a yard or garden of the month club
- Beautification projects
- In other words get our club educated and involved in conservation projects

The Conservation Chair is to keep a binder of all activities to pass on to the next Conservation Chair.

The Conservation Chair is to keep track of volunteer hours, in-kind donation, money donated, and members who attended a Conservation activity and send that information to the Dean of Chairs within a month of the activity.

The Conservation Chair shall attend all monthly General Meetings, and Board Meetings. If you can not attend one of the meetings report out to the Dean of Chairs
