

## **Chair Descriptions**

### **Domestic Violence Chair**

**The Domestic Violence Chair is to promote domestic violence awareness, education, and ways we can help local shelters and the community. They can be things such as:**

- Volunteer at shelters
- Arrange a tour of shelters
- Collect items shelters may need (you are to collect and deliver items)
- Volunteer at fundraisers that help domestic violence victims
- Mentioning a law that was passed regarding domestic violence against women and children
- Awareness about:
  - o bullying in schools
  - o Sexual offenses
  - o Child abduction/sex trade
- Walks/runs that bring domestic violence awareness
- Making and wearing purple ribbons in October to bring domestic violence awareness

**The Domestic Violence Chair is to keep a binder of all activities to pass on to the next Domestic Violence Chair.**

**The Domestic Violence Chair is to keep track of volunteer hours, in-kind donation, money donated, and members who attended a Domestic Violence activity and send that information to the Dean of Chairs within a month of the activity.**

**The Domestic Violence Chair shall attend all monthly General Meetings, and Board Meetings.**
