## Chair Descriptions Domestic Violence Chair

The Domestic Violence Chair is to promote domestic violence awareness, education, and ways we can help local shelters and the community. They can be things such as:

- Volunteer at shelters
- Arrange a tour of shelters
- Collect items shelters may need (you are to collect and deliver items)
- Volunteer at fundraisers that help domestic violence victims
- Mentioning a law that was passed regarding domestic violence against women and children
- Awareness about:
  - o bullying in schools
  - Sexual offenses
  - Child abduction/sex trade
- Walks/runs that bring domestic violence awareness
- Making and wearing purple ribbons in October to bring domestic violence awareness

The Domestic Violence Chair is to keep a binder of all activities to pass on to the next Domestic Violence Chair.

The Domestic Violence Chair is to keep track of volunteer hours, in-kind donation, money donated, and members who attended a Domestic Violence activity and send that information to the Dean of Chairs within a month of the activity.

**The Domestic Violence Chair shall attend all monthly General Meetings, and Board Meetings.** If you can not attend one of the meetings report out to the Dean of Chairs
