## Chair Descriptions Send Out Card Chair

## The Send Out Card Chair is to represent the Woman's Club of Fullerton by sending out cards for occasions such as:

- Member birthdays
- Member get well cards
- Member bereavement cards
- Thank you cards to:
  - Guests who have attended our General Monthly Meetings
  - Those that have presented at our General Monthly Meetings and/or other events
  - Any other occasion that warrants a thank you
  - Work with the Ways and Means Chair as to who sends thank you cards to those who have sponsored or donated to an event or the WCOF
- Welcome card to new WCOF members that join

## The Send Out Cards Chair is to do her best to be aware of occasions that a card should be sent.

- Get information from the Membership Chair for:
  - Guests who attend the General Monthly Meetings
  - New WCOF members that join
  - Current WCOF roster with birthday information
- Work with Ways and Means Chair on any cards that the Send Out Card Chair needs to send
- Work with Program Chair to get information on any presenter and/or program at our General Monthly Meetings in which a thank you card should be sent
- Inform the WCOF members that they are to let the President and/or an Executive Board member know when a member is sick and/or going through a hard time
  - Get approval when in doubt whether to send a card out on behalf of the WCOF
  - Always make sure to report out at the Executive Board Meeting and/or by email

## The Send Out Card Chair is to keep a binder of all activities to pass on to the next Public Issues Chair.

The Send Out Card Chair is to keep track of volunteer hours, in-kind donation, money donated, and members who have helped with Send Out Cards and send that information to the Dean of Chairs within a month of the activity.

**The Send Out Cards Chair shall attend all monthly General Meetings, and Board Meetings.** If you can not attend one of the meetings report out to the Dean of Chairs

Note: when a chair or co-chair is not actively engaged in her position she will be asked to step down.
